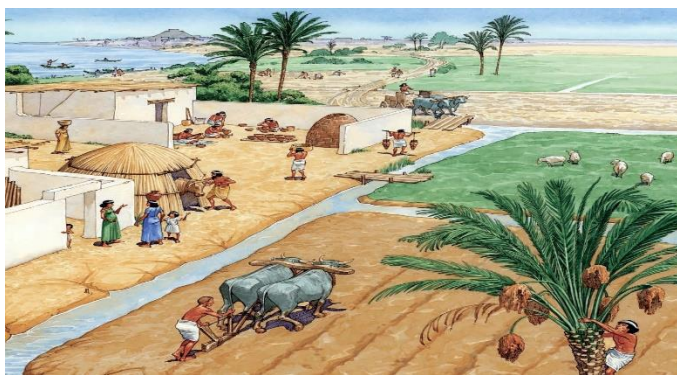


Year 1 History Knowledge Organiser - Prehistoric Britain

prehistoric	A time in the past that happened when people did not write things down.
artefact	An object made by people that gives us information about life in the past.
Celts	A tribe who came from Europe and lived in Great Britain around 750 BC.
