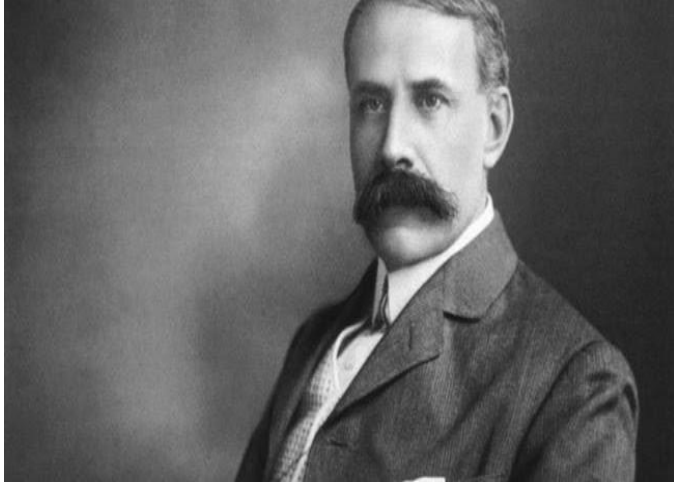

Bassoon: A bass woodwind instrument from the oboe family.

Vocabulary

Wind quintet - five people playing woodwind and brass instruments.

Crochet - a note played for one quarter of the duration.

Quaver - an eighth note in music.

Proms - A concert of classical music at which part of the audience stands, in particular one of a series of concerts performed annually at the Royal Albert Hall in London.

Patriotic - having or expressing devotion to and vigorous support for one's country.

Conductor - a person who directs the performance of an orchestra or choir.
